Cuyahoga Land Bank receives award for Excellence from State of Ohio Auditor

The Cuyahoga County Land Reutilization Corporation, which was established in 2009 and is commonly known as the Cuyahoga Land Bank, recently concluded its third annual audit by the State of Ohio Auditor.
